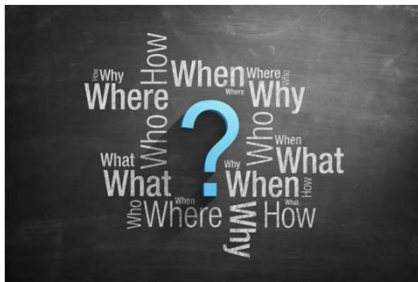
Technical Assistance Team

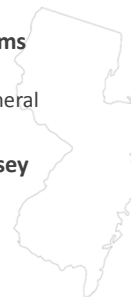

Volunteer supervision and retention

- Benchmarks for growth and development

- New staff orientation
- Role-specific addendums

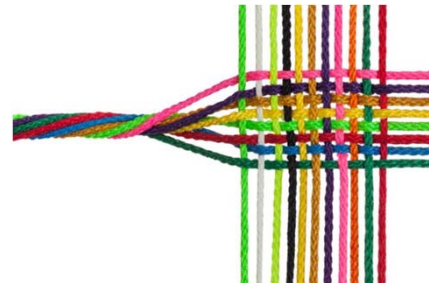
